Pacemaker Steel and Piping Company of Utica and Binghamton distributes approximately 50,000 different items of steel, aluminum, pipe, valves and fittings to manufacturers and contractors throughout New York State and northern Pennsylvania. In 1956 at the age of 27, F. Eugene Romano founded Pacemaker Steel Warehouse, Inc., a distributor and processor of industrial steel and aluminum. In 1969, Charles Millar Supply of Utica (founded 1861) was acquired and the surviving company became Pacemaker Steel and Piping Company, Inc.

Pacemaker is a proud member of the community and supports charities of all types, especially those dedicated to education and enhancing the lives of those in need. Mr. Romano was a member of The Boys Club in Utica, New York, and recognizes the value of such an organization to our youth of today.
